Updates from the Cameron Station Civic Association



The Cameron Station Civic Association is a neighbor-led group committed to keeping residents informed and advocating for our community's interests. From city policies and development projects to traffic, public safety, and green space, the Civic Association monitors meetings, events, and initiatives that may impact life in and around Cameron Station.

Access Improvements at Landmark

Monday, June 15, 2026: Deadline to "postmark" written comments on the Access Improvements at Landmark Project to "request that a public hearing be held" by mailing "a written request to: Demond Frazier, Project Manager, Department of Transportation and Environmental Services – Project Implementation, City of Alexandria, 2331 Mill Road, Suite 302, Alexandria, VA 22314." The City stated that "[i]f a request for a public hearing is received, and the concerns addressed in the request cannot be adequately resolved, a public hearing will be scheduled at a time and place to be advertised in a future notice ... Questions regarding this project should be directed to Demond Frazier at Demond.Frazier@alexandriava.gov or 703.746.4362." Per the City, the enhancements planned for North Van Dorn Street, from approximately Duke Street to Holmes Run Parkway, include: Expanded sidewalks; Additional crosswalks and pedestrian signals; ADA compliant curb ramps; New guardrails; New streetlights; and, Relocated stormwater inlets. The design stage for the project will last through May 2027 with construction planned from March 2027 through August 2029. Residents are **required** per the **Design & Maintenance Standards** to submit an application for approval from the Architectural Review Committee prior to making any exterior modification to your home or lot. [Click here](#) for more information.

It is important to note the upcoming ARC meeting dates and the application due date/time for your request. If questions, information, and/or documents are not received by the application due date, your application will be scheduled for the following month (based on finalizing your application).

If you submit an external modification application, it is important **to attend the ARC meeting at which your application will be considered**, via Zoom. The meeting link is located on the **ARC webpage**, and these meetings are open to all residents. If specific questions arise and the ARC does not have sufficient information regarding your application, it will be tabled to a future

meeting until all questions are answered and the ARC has a full understanding of your home project.

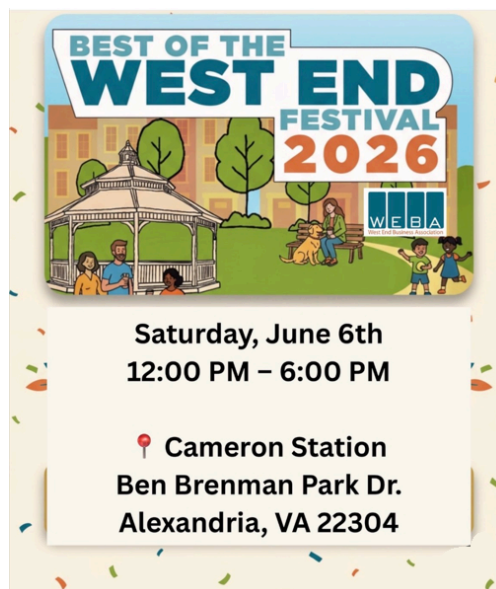
